Allowing her arm to be twisted by others, she ran for the Board of Directors of the Unit. In the process of learning about the politics and management of the organization, in the Unit and the ACBL itself, she learned how to run tournaments and has chaired or co-chaired numerous Regionals and Sectionals.

As President of Unit 166 for five years, she oversaw many changes. She retired from the Board a few years ago, but her commitment to the game drew her back after the Board lost two of its key personalities (Irene Warner and Fred Andreychuk, both Kate Buckman Award winners). When will she retire again? When she decides she's not needed. That could be a long time from now!

Her contributions in all areas of the game we all love make her a most deserving recipient of this Award. Our heartiest congratulations from all you friends, partners, students and fellow board members.

What Newcomers Should Know About the Laws and the Game Director – Who is Responsible for the Dummy



(This series of articles by Mike Flader is taken from "The Bridge Teacher" August 2008 edition. Ed.)

Many players believe that “everyone is responsible for the dummy” and that if the dummy revokes there is no way the Director can adjust the score when the defenders are damaged as a result.

Wrong on both counts. Since about 1987 the Laws have been changed to make the responsibility for properly displaying the dummy the task of the dummy player. If he displays the dummy in a sloppy manner and this works to his side’s advantage (one card may be hidden behind another, for example), the Director can award an adjusted score. If something like this happens to you, same advice as before: Call the Director.
