

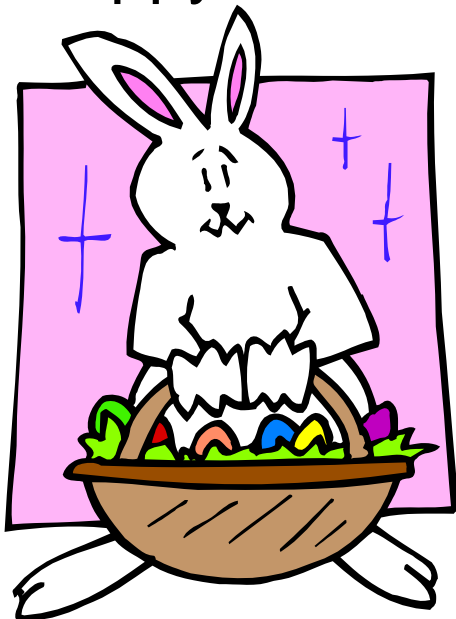

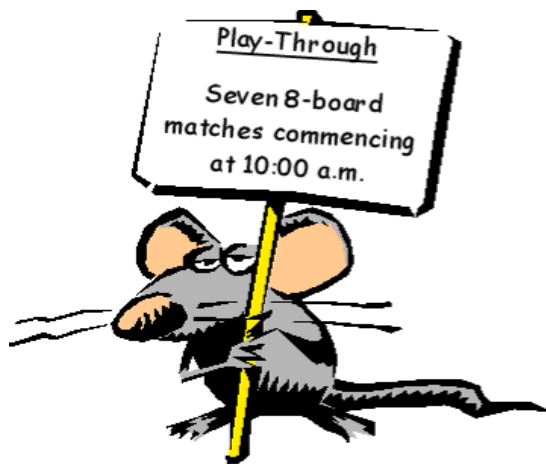

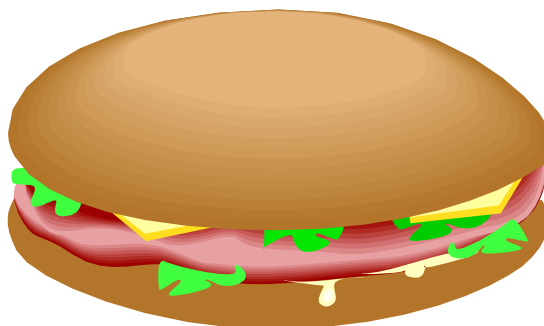
When Murray opened in 3rd seat (with one of his legendary light openers), Korbel bid 1NT to make sure E-W didn't steal the hand from them. Carruthers doubled for penalties ("cards") which Murray naturally pulled. Wolpert then came out of the bushes and bid 3NT. Carruthers led a heart which Korbel won to play a club to the Q and K. Carruthers exited with a diamond to the Ace and a heart came back. Since Korbel's opponents are both world-class players, he was quite confident that Carruthers would duck the club K holding K J X originally, so he played a club to the Ace for +400 when the Jack fell. Their teammates were -50 in 2♠.

If your team has a "1" beside it you have won a prize but two "1's" do not mean two prizes.

Interesting Hand

The following hand came up during one of the KO events a couple of days ago. All participants have asked to remain anonymous.

N-S Vul; Hands rotated

♠ Q 7 3

South is declaring 3NT and receives a 4th best heart lead. East wins the Q and returns the 7. After some thought West plays the J forcing North to win with the K. This retained a heart in East's hand should he regain the lead. (*There is also the subtle inference that West does not have an entry, i.e. the ♠K. Ed.*) A thoughtful play that deserved a better fate.

Declarer ran 5 diamond tricks and West, thinking he had to protect his Spades, sluffed all 4 Clubs and eventually 1 Spade. The ♣Q followed, dummy rising with the ♣A when West showed out. Declarer now led his carefully preserved ♥6 and West ran his hearts. On the last heart this was the 3 card ending:

When West cashed the last heart, East was squeezed. This type of squeeze goes by the name of Fratricide Squeeze, not by the name of Suicide Squeeze or

Cannibal Squeeze as some players think. The former involves squeezing your partner while the latter involve squeezing yourself.

There was a break in tempo by East when the last heart was played and declarer correctly inferred that East held the ♠K. If East had calmly played the ♠6 in tempo, declarer might have gone wrong but he discarded the ♣J and ducked when the ♠J was led thus making 9 tricks. At the other table South went down 1 when West kept his clubs and declarer took the club finesse. The 12 IMP gain was instrumental in winning the match.

The interesting aspect of the hand is that declarer must go down if West doesn't cash the last heart but instead plays the ♠J. East is no longer squeezed. This is a very tough play to make, not cashing your winning heart. How many people do you know who are capable of this play?

When this hand was given to Deep Finesse, it said the N-S can only make 2NT. Deep Finesse seems to know about Fratricide Squeezes.

What Newcomers Should Know About the Laws and the Game Director – Hesitations



(This series of articles by Mike Flader is taken from "The Bridge Teacher" August 2008 edition. Ed.)

Newer players are very likely to hesitate in the normal course of playing in a bridge tournament. After all, they have less knowledge and experience, so, they are more likely to have a problem than those

of us who have been playing for a long time. What do we tell newcomers about these hesitations?

It's important to encourage them from the beginning to not think too long before making a decision. They need to learn to make a choice, live with it, and learn from it. When they become more experienced, we need to introduce the concept of how information is conveyed, both legitimately and illegitimately. Early in their bridge careers, they learned that a slow pass shows something different from a fast pass, and so on. At some point, they need to learn that when they hesitate or when their partner hesitates, the information conveyed by such action may only be used by the opponents (and then only at their own risk). They are not allowed to use the information in borderline situations, and, if they do so they may have the Director assigning them an adjusted score if the opponents are damaged.
