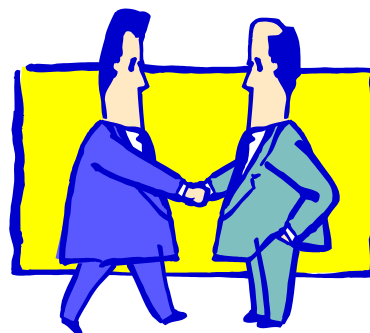

### Partnership Desks

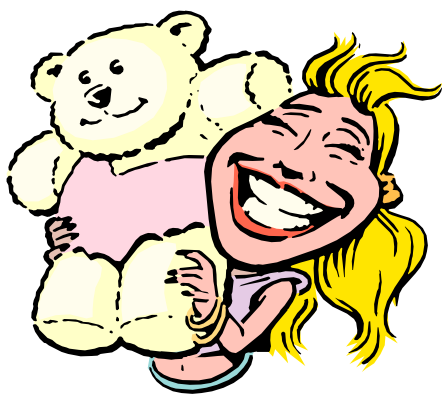
#### Open & Intermediate-Newcomers (I-N)

### Prizes & Prize Desk



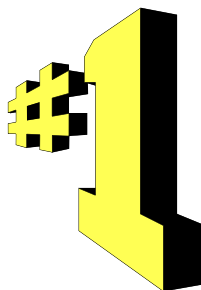

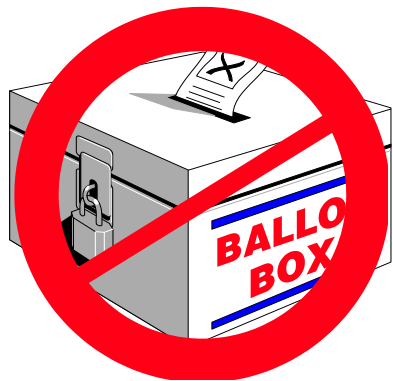
## Hospitality

## Unit 166 Elections – Not!



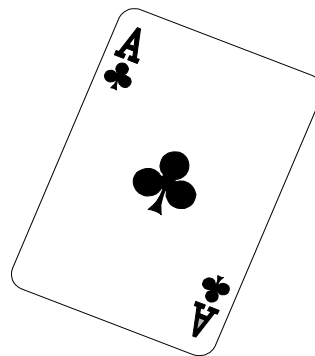

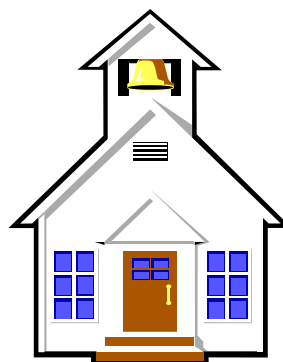

## What Newcomers Should Know About the Laws and the Game Director – Role of the Director



(This series of articles by Mike Flader is taken from "The Bridge Teacher" August 2008 edition. Ed.)

New players need to know that the Game Director is one of the "good guys". The Director's job is to come to the table whenever there is an irregularity in the bidding or play. The Director is the only person allowed to arbitrate the Laws. The role of the Director is to apply the Laws and provide possible redress for damages that may occur as the result of an irregularity. Newcomers need to be aware that irregularities occur all the time, even in the high-level open games. There is no need to feel a sense of embarrassment at having made a lead out of turn, a bid out of turn, an insufficient bid, etc. It happens to the best of players. More tomorrow.

(When you have to call the Director, the proper procedure is a polite "DIRECTOR, PLEASE" in a

voice sufficiently loud to be heard by the Director who may be some distance away. Try and avoid a very loud "DI-REK-TOR!!" as we all too often hear at tournaments. Ed.)
