## **Hazel Wolpert Wins Audrey Grant Award for 2009**



Hazel started her bridge career at a very early age in South Africa. When she was seven years old she started watching her parents play and was often asked to be the dummy when someone went to the washroom. She got many compliments about her dummy play. Eventually, as a big treat, her parents would allow her to fill in for a hand or two.

When she was 15 she started playing duplicate with her sister-in-law Sarah Bresge in Johannesburg. When she arrived in Canada in 1977, being a school teacher, there were no jobs to be found. Not to mention having a two year old to take care of. That's when she decided to teach her friends how to play bridge and soon found a job as a bridge teacher for

the board of education. Every chance she got she played duplicate bridge at Ted Horning's Bridge Club.

Her elder son Darren first learned how to play bridge at the age of 15 when Hazel offered to teach a group of kids how to play. Darren realized early on that to really be accepted into the family you had to know how to play bridge. He soon accepted this fact and became an avid bridge player. Her younger son Gavin decided to rebel against the addiction he found in the rest of the family. He vowed never ever to play bridge. But as we all know things change and so did Gavin. He is now a bridge professional.

Hazel would be remiss if she did not say that it was her mother's passion for the game that motivated them all. In her later years whenever she was required to go to hospital (sometimes for major surgery) her first question to the doctor would be "Could I leave this afternoon in time for the 1 pm bridge game?". Even Hazel's husband-to-be, Myer, was told in the earlier stages of dating that learning how to play bridge was mandatory. She can

The winner of the Audrey Grant Award for 2009 is **Hazel Wolpert**, a well-known and respected teacher and bridge club owner-operator in the Toronto area. remember so clearly having to stop playing bridge abruptly with her mother, father and Myer because she had to go to the hospital to give birth to Darren!

The highlights of her bridge career are:

1. Having her boys Darren and Gavin represent Canada on the same team.
2. Winning the Canadian Woman's Team Championship. The really fun part was coming back from being down by over 50 imps in the

finals. Of course she found going to Turkey to represent Canada to be really exciting.

3. Gavin and Jenny (his wife) winning the Blue Ribbon Pairs in 2005.
4. Opening her own bridge club and having a tremendous amount of support from the bridge community. It was very scary opening up her own business but she has been very lucky (*Not to mention a lot of hard work. Ed.*) and she can only say thank you to everyone who supports the club, making it one of the most successful clubs in North America.

*"My advice to bridge players is don't be afraid of making mistakes but try and learn from them. Bridge should be called the game of least mistakes because it is the pair that makes the fewest mistakes that usually comes out on top.*

*Thank you for the award. I feel most honoured."*

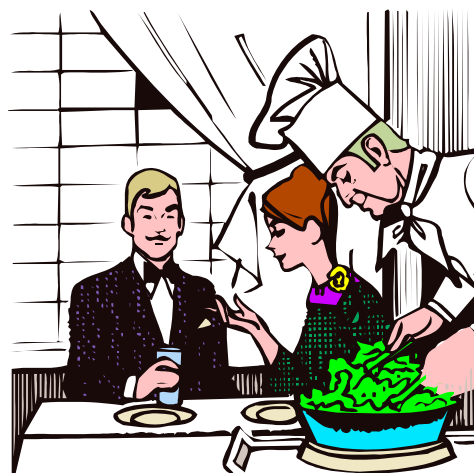

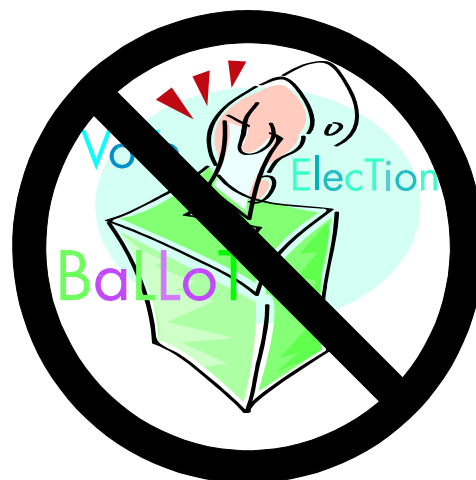


## **Louise McNeely**

## What Newcomers Should Know About the Laws and the Game Director – Role of the Non-Offender

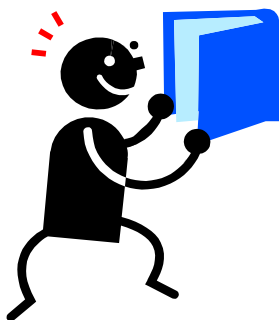
When an irregularity occurs in the bidding or play, someone at the table must call the Director. When one of the players (usually a non-offender) chooses instead to say what should happen following an irregularity or gives the supposed penalty for the offense committed, that player is in violation of the Laws. Only the Director can tell you what the correct procedure is and only the Director is empowered to apply the Laws. Most players do not mean to violate the Laws; they think they are either saving the Director the trouble of coming to the table or taking an action that is more timely. They don't see themselves in the same category as the player who has led out of turn or revoked, but they become offenders themselves when they take this type of action. Even experienced players occasionally make errors when they make their own rulings. Bottom line – call the Director whenever an irregularity occurs.
